Please Do Not Bring Boats to Registration/Rules meeting Fish Limits Fish size: Walleye, 15 inches and over. Each boat is allowed to Weigh a max limit of three (3) fish per boat, per day. When a 3rd fish is placed in the livewell, you are done fishing for the day. Culling is NOT allowed. Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable. Any dead fish will be inspected and weighed or not weighed at the discretion of tournament officials. At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 Chest type life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch. Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty. Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies. The tournament waters for this event shall be the Bay of Green Bay within the WI North Zone Walleye Tournament boundaries and all Michigan waters, except for Little Bay De Noc. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limits. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre- tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament yaters. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
