Fish Limits	Site Host	Boundaries-
 Fish size: Walleye, 15 inches and over. Each boat is allowed to Weigh a max limit of five (5) fish per boat, per day. No more than (5) fish allowed in the livewell. Culling is not allowed. Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish. Every effort must be made to keep your fish alive and fresh until they reach the bump sink. At NO time may they be put on ice. Any dead fish will be inspected and weighed or not weighed at the discretion of tournament officials. All North Dakota Game and Fish Department fishing and boating rules and regulations must be followed. All contestants must have a valid fishing license, produce it upon request, Each participating angler is limited to no more than two (2) fishing lines (rods). Each participating angler must cast for, hook and reel (retrieve) their own fish.	The tournament waters for this event shall be Lake Sakakawea and shall include rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above- mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limits. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre- tournament briefing. Only water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
