Mandatory On-site Check-in Times:

3:00 p.m. – Check in Opens 5:00 p.m. – Check in Closes.

5:15 p.m. - Start of the mandatory briefing. All Anglers must attend.

All anglers must off the water by 3:00 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.

Fish Limits

Fish size: Walleye, 15 inches and over.

Each boat is allowed to Weigh a max limit of five (5) fish per boat, per day. No more than (5) fish allowed in the livewell. **Culling is not allowed.**

Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.

An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable. Any dead fish will be inspected and weighed or not weighed at the discretion of tournament officials.

All North Dakota Game and Fish Department fishing and boating rules and regulations must be followed. All contestants must have a valid fishing license, produce it upon request,

Each participating angler is limited to no more than two (2) fishing lines (rods). Each participating angler must cast for, hook and reel (retrieve) their own fish.

<u>Contingency Programs</u> - Pros & Co-Anglers

If you think you might be eligible for a Ranger, Nitro or Triton boat contingency you MUST have your Boat HIN # with you before you come to Pre-Tournament Check-in on Friday evening.

Required Safety Equipment

It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.

At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 Chest type life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.

Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.

Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies.

Boundaries-

The tournament waters for this event shall be Lake Sakakawea and shall include rivers. creeks and canals connecting to the abovementioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limits. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pretournament briefing. Only water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
