All Anglers must attend.</b></p> <p><b>All anglers must off the water by 12:00 p.m (NOON) Sept 3, 2024.</b>  <b>Please Do Not Bring Boats to Registration/Rules meeting.</b></p>	<p>Au Sable Harbor of Refuge                      AuSable Charter TWP, MI 48750</p> <p>Wednesday, Thursday and Friday,                      Sept. 4-6, 2024</p> <p>Take-off begins at 7:00 a.m. or first safe light.</p> <p>Weigh-In begins at 3:00 p.m.</p>	<p>It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.</p> <p>At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 Chest type life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.</p> <p>Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.</p> <p>Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies.</p>
<p><u>Fish Limits</u></p> <p>Fish size: Walleye, 15 inches and over.</p> <p>Each boat is allowed to Weigh a max limit of five (5) fish per boat, per day. No more than (5) fish allowed in the livewell. Culling is allowed.</p> <p>Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.</p> <p>An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable. Lake Street                      Oscoda, MI 48750                      PH: 989-747-4700  <a href="#">Website</a></p>	<p><u>Boundaries-</u></p> <p>The tournament waters shall be U.S. waters of Lake Huron and shall include U.S. waters of rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above-mentioned waters, with the following exceptions: Waters upstream of the Soo Locks(Lake Superior), waters west of the Mackinac Bridge(Lake Michigan) and waters downstream of the westbound lane of the Interstate 69 Bridge (St Clair River) are off limits for fishing. Lake Huron waters within these boundaries posted “off limits” or “no fishing” by state or federal agencies will be off limits. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits as will any additional off limits announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament’s contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply. You may traverse through Canadian waters to access U.S. fishing locations and for safety, but you may not fish in them.</p>
