### Pre-Event On-Site Check-In /Rules Meeting

Date: Wednesday, July 9, 2025

Mandatory On-site Check-in Times: 4:00 p.m. - Check in Opens 5:00 p.m. – Check in Closes. 5:15 p.m. - Start of the mandatory briefing. All Anglers must attend.

All anglers must be off the water by 3:00 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting. Please Do Not Bring Boats to Registration/Rules meeting.

### **Fish Limits**

Fish size: Walleye, 15 inches and over.

Each boat is allowed to present ONLY five (5) fish at the bump sink and weigh in max (5) fish per day. No more than twelve (12) fish allowed in the live well. Release any live fish not be weighed prior to final run to check-in. DO NOT bring any extra fish to the bump sink. Culling is allowed.

Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.

An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be nonreleasable. Any dead fish will be inspected and weighed or not weighed at the discretion of tournament officials.

## **Required Safety Equipment**

It is the responsibility of all anglers to have the required state and federal safety equipment on board.

At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 Chest type life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and demonstrate functioning kill switch.

An inspection will be held during the lineup for take-off. Live wells must be empty.

Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies.

# **Boundaries-**

The tournament waters for this event shall be U.S. waters of Lake Huron and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above - mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pretournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply. Canadian Waters are NOT open for fishing.
