<p><u>Location:</u> Clarion Hotel & Conference Center (outdoor pavilion) 30 Lake Shore Drive East Dunkirk, NY 14048</p> <p><u>Date:</u> Wednesday, August 6, 2025</p> <p><u>Mandatory On-site Check-in Times:</u> 4:00 p.m. – Check in Opens 5:00 p.m. – Check in Closes. 5:15 p.m. – Start of the mandatory briefing. All Anglers must attend.</p> <p>All anglers must be off the water by 3:00 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting. Please Do Not Bring Boats to Registration/Rules meeting.</p>	<p>Dunkirk City Pier 2 Central Ave Dunkirk, NY 14048</p> <p>Thursday and Friday, August 7-8, 2025</p> <p>Take-off begins at 7:00 a.m. or first safe light.</p> <p>Weigh-In begins at 3:15 p.m.</p> <p>Anglers may use any launch they wish to unload/load their boat.</p>	<p>It is the responsibility of all anglers to have the required state and federal safety equipment on board.</p> <p>At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 Chest type life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and demonstrate functioning kill switch.</p> <p>An inspection will be held during the lineup for take-off. Live wells must be empty.</p> <p>Keep marine band radios on Channel 72 for tournament information and use Channel 16 for emergencies.</p>
<p><u>Fish Limits</u> Fish size: Walleye, 15 inches and over.</p> <p>Each boat is allowed to present ONLY five (5) fish at the bump sink and weigh in max (5) fish per day. No one angler may place more than (6) fish in the boat and no more than (12) fish per boat may be possessed per day. DO NOT bring any extra fish to the bump sink. Culling is NOT allowed.</p> <p>Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.</p> <p>An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limits. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply. Please follow all applicable laws and regulations</p>
