<p>Location: Ray Roberts Marina 1399 Marina Cir, Sanger, TX 76266</p> <p>Date: Friday, May 15, 2026</p> <p>Registration/On-site Check-in</p> <p>Times: 4:00 p.m. – Registration Opens 6:00 p.m. – Registration Closes</p> <p>Check in is mandatory of every team</p> <p>Anglers must be off the water by 6:00p.m.</p>	<p>Location: Ray Roberts Marina 1399 Marina Cir, Sanger, TX 76266</p> <p>Saturday May 16, 2026</p> <p>Take-off will begin at 6:30 a.m. or first safe light thereafter.</p> <p>Weigh-in begins at 3:00 p.m.</p>	<p>It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.</p> <p>At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 chest type life jacket worn by each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.</p> <p>Inspection will be held as boats are released during takeoff. Live wells must be empty.</p>
<p>Fish Limits</p> <p>Fish size: 5 fish, 14" inches and over.</p> <p>Each Team is allowed to weigh-in a limit of five (5) fish, per day. Culling of a dead fish is not allowed.</p> <p>Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.</p> <p>A 8-ounce penalty will be deducted for each dead Bass presented for weigh-in. Culling of dead bass is prohibited. No dead bass will be eligible for Big Bass awards or prizes</p>	<p>Allowed Practice Date ONLY for Pre-registered teams –</p> <p>PLEASE READ THE RULES CAREFULLY! - Membership & Entry Fees MUST be paid before launching to pre-fish on any allowed designated practice day, per the rule #6.</p> <p>Ray Roberts - Off-limits: 05/11-05/15</p> <p>Allowed practiced day for pre-registered teams ONLY: 05/15</p>	<p>Boundaries</p> <p>See off limits map available at registration on Friday.</p> <p>The tournament waters for this event shall be Lake Ray Roberts. Contestants may fish anywhere on tournament waters accessible by boat, except areas designated as "off limits", "no boats", "keep out", "restricted" or "no fishing" (or similar language or markings intended to restrict public access) by state or federal officials or within 50 yards of a competitor's boat which was first anchored. See rule #15 for anchored definition. Any additional off limits will be announced at Friday night registration. Only water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.</p>
