<b>Date:</b> Friday, June 5, 2026 <b>Registration/On-site Check-in Time:</b> 4:00 p.m. – Registration Opens 6:00 p.m. – Registration Closes <b>Check in is mandatory of every team</b> You must be off the water by 6:00p.m.	<b>Sat. &amp; Sun. June 6-7, 2026</b> MANDITORY Boat inspection begins at 4:30am each day at Bass Pro Shops. ALL teams MUST attend.  Weigh-in begins at Bass Pro shops 2:30pm.	At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 chest type life jacket worn by each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.  Inspection will be held as boats are released during takeoff. Live wells must be empty.
<b>Fish Limits</b>  Fish size: 14 inches and over  Each Team is allowed to weigh-in a limit of five (5) fish, per day. Culling of a dead fish is not allowed.  Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.  A 8-ounce penalty for each dead Bass presented for weigh-in. Culling of dead bass is prohibited. No dead bass will be eligible for Big Bass awards or prizes.	<b>Allowed Practice Date ONLY for Pre-registered teams –</b>  PLEASE READ THE RULES CAREFULLY! - Membership & Entry Fees MUST be paid before launching to pre-fish on any allowed designated practice day, per the rule #6.  <b>Lake Palestine - Off-limits:</b> 06/1 - 06/5  <b>Allowed practiced day for pre-registered teams ONLY</b> 06/4 & 06/5	<b>Boundaries</b> See off limits map available at registration at Bass Pro Shops.  The tournament waters for this event shall be Lake Palestine. Contestants may fish anywhere on tournament waters accessible by boat, except areas designated as "off limits", "no boats", "keep out", "restricted" or "no fishing" (or similar language or markings intended to restrict public access) by state or federal officials or within 50 yards of a competitor's boat which was first anchored. See rule #15 for anchored definition. Any additional off limits will be announced at Friday night registration. Only water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
